



Liberty Hall Pool Rules

Revised April 2018

- Only residents with an active pool pass will be allowed on the premises. Letting in others with an inactive pass or without a pass is prohibited. Those who enter without an active pool card will be considered trespassing. Those who let others in, who do not have an active pool card, may have their pool card revoked.
- The premises is monitored by surveillance cameras.
- The pool will be open 7:00am until 8:00pm daily, or as the Board of Directors specifies.
- **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.** Anyone using the pool does so at his or her own risk.
- No glass containers are allowed.
- Propping the pool gate open is prohibited.

Liberty Hall Pool Rules Continued...

- Residents whom are 15 - 18 years of age may only have 1 guest, 15 years old or older, at the pool. Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a family member at least 18 years of age. Residents are encouraged to ask unaccompanied children to leave. A resident of the community must accompany guests at all times.
- No street clothes or disposable diapers allowed in the pool. Children that are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper when in the pool.
- Residents without an approved reservation may not have more than 5 non-resident guests per home at the pool. Additionally, the residents must accompany their guests at all times.
- Running, rough play, pushing, acrobatics, dunking, wrestling, splashing, yelling, diving or jumping haphazardly, snapping of towels, improper conduct causing undue disturbances, including abusive or

profane language, on or about the pool area or any acts which would endanger any patron are prohibited.

- No throwing hard objects (Frisbees, balls, etc.) in pool area.
- Small personal flotation devices are allowed. No flotation device over 3' x3' will be allowed in the pool. During times of excessive pool use flotation devices may be prohibited from use in the pool.
- **NO GLASS CONTAINERS.** All coolers will be subject to inspection. Coolers that contain glass will not be allowed inside the pool area. If a glass bottle is broken, the entire pool must be drained and the offending party will be financially responsible for the cost associated with cleaning and refilling the pool. Trash and/or recycling must be discarded in the appropriate receptacle.
- All pool users must clean up after themselves.

Liberty Hall Pool Rules Continued...

- Eating, drinking or chewing gum is not permitted in the pool.
- There should be no spitting, blowing nose or urinating in pool. If defecation occurs within the pool, the pool will close immediately.
- Persons with diarrhea, illness or nausea shall not enter the pool.
Persons wearing bandages, having colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections, sores, open cuts/wounds or any other infectious disease, condition or skin condition shall not use the pool.
- No animals or pets are allowed in the pool enclosure.
- No use of tobacco or vaping products are allowed in the pool area.
- No loud music. Only the use of personal listening devices is allowed. Should any music bother other pool guests, the music must be shut off.
- All pool users must take a shower before entering the pool.

- No street clothes or disposable diapers allowed in the pool. Children that are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper when in the pool. Proper bathing suits are the only appropriate attire for use in the pool.
- Wheeled vehicles, with the exception of wheelchairs and baby strollers, are not permitted in the fenced pool area. Bikes, skateboards and roller blades are to be parked/left outside the fenced area in the appropriate places and not blocking the gate or walkway.
- Parking is limited to the paved parking area by the pool. Vehicles parked on the grass or roadway may be towed at the homeowner's expense. Vehicles parked in the assigned numbered spots will be towed at the owner's expense.

- When lightning is sighted, the pool area must be evacuated immediately.
- The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen articles, accidents or injuries arising from the use of the pool and/or the pool area, or cabana house.
- Please close umbrellas when you leave.
- Homeowners, residents, and guest who do not obey the pool rules may have their access to the amenity revoked and/or be subject to prosecution as the Board of Directors sees fit.
